We will work to create more **affordable, warm and sustainable homes**:

- > Build more council, social and affordable homes
- Improve existing housing stock by promoting use of Homes
 Upgrade Grants and Disabled Facilities Grants
- > Support new homes acquisitions
- Better meet the urgent needs of families in temporary accommodation
- > Strengthen enforcement of private rental standards
- Implement North Essex Housing Summit action plan
- Support the Tendring & Colchester Garden Community, providing a new country park, social and affordable housing, infrastructure-first development, local employment, and sustainable transport schemes



We will work to create secure jobs, fair pay and skills:

- Work with Colchester Institute, the University of Essex, Adult Learning Centres and others to boost local learning, employment and skills
- > Promote the real living wage and fair pay
- Work with co-operatives, mutually-owned organisations and others to build community wealth
- > Boost inward investment into our city's businesses
- > Promote sustainable procurement to deliver social value
- Identify and address inequalities across the city to promote fairer life chances



We will work to create more **thriving and healthy communities**:

- Improve our bus services, bus station and active travel routes
- > Improve our air and river quality
- > Plan or improve a playpark in every community
- Strengthen 'Live Well Neighbourhoods' plans to improve access to local health, mental health and social care services
- Work with 'One Colchester' to extend social prescribing to ease pressure on NHS services where appropriate
- Implement the new Women's Health Strategy co-developed with the local Integrated Care Board



We will work to create **safer, cleaner streets and** we will **crack down on crime:**

- > Press for increased community and neighbourhood policing
- Push the local Community Safety Partnership to create a more effective plan to tackle crime in the city
- Work with Colchester Borough Homes, other housing providers, Neighbourhood Watch, zone teams and residents' groups to tackle fly-tipping, anti-social behaviour and to build community cohesion
- Press for a devolved road and pavement repair budget so potholes and floods are dealt with at pace
- Work with One Colchester and others to make city streets and the night-time economy safer, particularly for women
- > Strengthen multi-agency support for victims of crime
- Improve city employees' ability to identify and safeguard vulnerable adults and children



We will work to protect and enhance our vibrant city centre, heritage and green spaces

- Celebrate, promote and market the unrivalled heritage, arts, culture and landscape of our city
- Deliver the £40 million Town Deal investments for St Botolph's, Jumbo and Greenstead
- Use the City Centre Masterplan to leverage new investments into heritage, entertainment and retail
- Protect Middlewick entirely from housing by making it a designated 'local green space' or nature reserve
- Promote and protect public access to facilities in our existing country parks
- Review our sport and leisure offer to ensure these meet the needs of our diverse communities and age groups
- Build on our city status to promote Colchester as the best place to live, invest, work and rest
